The scientist will also be asked to provide a short description of the work by August 1st, 2017 that visitors can read as the artworks take shape on Saturday, August 12th, 2017. Participants will also be asked to be available for an hour or two at the event to answer any questions that visitors may have about their work.

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply, applicants must be a current PhD student or an early-career researcher in their first 5 years of post-PhD research based in ACT. Applicants are welcome from all fields of science, technology, engineering, mathematics and medicine.
